



Group Scores for 2010-2011

CCCA students score well within the top quartile in reading and math at every grade level on the Stanford Achievement Test. We create a safe, loving yet challenging environment where each child is enriched or supported according to individual need. Please note that the staff and faculty of CCCA have chosen NOT to disaggregate scores. In other words, we do not exclude scores of students based on learning disability, ESL students or those with service plans. Our students, collectively, score well beyond the national average (50th) at every grade level as reflected in the chart below. Well done.

*National Percentile Rank – indicates the relative standing of a student in comparison with other students in the same grade in the norm (reference) group who took the test at a comparable time. Percentile ranks range from a low of 1 to a high of 99, with 50 denoting average performance for the grade. The percentile rank corresponding to a given score indicates the percentage of students in the same grade obtaining scores equal to or less than that score. Since percentiles cannot be averaged the group of scores is converted into NCEs, the NCEs are averaged and the mean is then converted back into a percentile rank.
